

Subject: Minutes of CSC Meeting — Evaluation of Financial Proposals (Package-II, Rural Growth Centre, Tharparkar)

A meeting of the Consultant Selection Committee (CSC) was held on **8th January 2026 at 2:00 PM** in the Committee Room of the Directorate, under the Chairmanship of the Project Director, Project Management & Implementation Unit (PMIU) – Rural Growth Centre (RGC) under PRS. The meeting was convened to evaluate the financial proposals of the technically qualified firms i.e. M/s. EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd, M/s. CGD Consulting Pvt. Ltd. and M/s Epsilon Technologies for the hiring of Design, Supervision, and Monitoring Consultancy Services for **Package-II (Rural Growth Centre – Tharparkar)**.

2. At the outset, the Member Secretary informed the Committee that six (06) firms had submitted their technical and financial proposals for the subject assignment. Upon evaluation of the technical proposals by the CSC, three (03) firms were declared technically qualified. The details are provided below:

3. The case of M/s Epsilon Technologies was taken up first for discussion by the CSC. Before proceeding with the evaluation of its financial proposal, the Member Secretary apprised the Committee of the responses received from the concerned executing departments regarding verification of the firm's experience claimed in its technical proposal. The details are summarized below:

4. Four projects were considered while evaluating the technical proposal of M/s Epsilon Technologies, and all were referred to the respective executing departments for verification. However, based on the responses received from the Public Health Engineering Division Malakand and the Project Management Unit, Sanitary & Sewerage System Gilgit City, the CSC members were of the view that the firm be disqualified due to fraudulent practices and submission of fake experience certificates. Accordingly, the CSC members unanimously agreed to disqualify M/s Epsilon Technologies.

5. With respect to M/s EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd., only one relevant project experience was considered during the technical evaluation, which was duly verified by the executing department, namely the Sindh Coal Authority, Government of Sindh. However, discrepancies were observed in the firm's financial proposal. The bid price stated in the covering letter was PKR 68,494,000 (inclusive of taxes), whereas the total amount shown in Form FIN-3 was calculated as PKR 76,899,000.

6. Additionally, the remuneration for the design phase was calculated at PKR 6,749,000, while the reimbursable expenses for the same phase were quoted as PKR 59,560,000, resulting in a total design phase cost of PKR 66,309,000. The remuneration for the supervision phase was quoted at PKR 10,590,000. Consequently, the cumulative financial breakup (PKR 76,899,000) exceeded the bid price quoted in the covering letter (PKR 68,494,000). For evaluation purposes, the Consultant Selection Committee (CSC) unanimously decided to consider the corrected bid price of M/s EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. as PKR 76,899,000. After deduction of 15% tax, as indicated in the bid, the evaluated cost worked out to PKR 66,868,695.65, which was accordingly used for the final ranking of the firms.

7. The financial proposal submitted by M/s CGD Consulting Pvt. Ltd. was thoroughly reviewed, and no arithmetic errors were observed. The firm quoted a design cost of PKR 19,730,000 and a supervision cost of PKR 37,300,000. Applicable taxes include 15% SRB and 6% Income Tax, bringing the total financial bid amount, inclusive of taxes, to PKR 69,519,570. Furthermore, the firm's experience has been verified by the PIU, Education City, Investment Department, Government of Sindh.

8. In light of the evaluation of all three technically qualified firms, M/s CGD Consulting Pvt. Ltd. and M/s EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd. were shortlisted for final evaluation in accordance with the QCBS method, with a weightage of 70% for the technical proposal and 30% for the financial proposal. The detailed calculations are presented below:

Ltd. being the 1st qualified bidder with the total cost of PKR 69,519,570 inclusive of all applicable taxes may be invited for contract agreement. 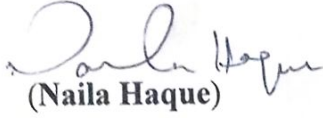
3. The Secretary/Member CSC completed all necessary EPADS formalities, including recording the attendance of CSC members. The bid prices opened are summarized below:

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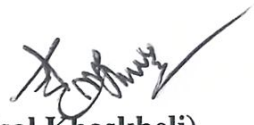

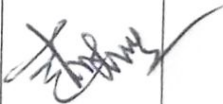

Subject: Minutes of Meeting of Consultant Selection Committee (CSC) for Re-evaluation of Technical Proposals in Light of Grievance Submitted by M/s Epsilon Technologies (WASH Project)

A meeting of the Consultant Selection Committee (CSC) was held on 19 December 2025 at 2:00 PM in the Committee Room of the Directorate, under the chairmanship of the Project Director, Project Management Implementation Unit (PMIU) – Rural Growth Centre (RGC), PRS. The meeting was convened to re-evaluate the technical proposals in light of the grievance submitted by M/s Epsilon Technologies regarding the non-consideration of one relevant WASH project during the technical evaluation of bidders uploaded on EPADS.

2. The CSC re-examined the WASH-related project experience of **M/s Epsilon Technologies**, details of which are enumerated below:

- i) Consultancy Services for Design Review & Construction Supervision for Water Supply, Sewerage, Drainage & Wastewater Treatment Projects in Newly Merged Districts (NMDs), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, amounting to **PKR 218.32 million**.
- ii) Consultancy Services for Water Supply Schemes / Rehabilitation / Sanitation in Thana Khas, Thana Bandajat, Malakand Khas, Audand, Dherai, Palai, Dheri Julagram, Totakan, Pirkhel, Agra, Upper Batkhela, Middle Batkhela, Lower Batkhela and Tehsil Dargai, District Malakand, amounting to **PKR 83 million**.
- iii) Sanitary Sewerage System with Treatment Plant for Gilgit City (PMC Services), amounting to **PKR 76 million**.
- iv) WASH Component Consultancy under the Disaster & Climate Resilience Improvement Project (DCRIP), amounting to **PKR 81 million**.

3. Previously, the CSC had been awarded 15 out of 20 marks for relevant experience. However, in light of the grievance, it was mutually agreed to consider the supervision component of one of the WASH project, namely *Consultancy Services for Design Review & Construction Supervision for Water Supply, Sewerage, Drainage & Wastewater Treatment Projects in Newly Merged Districts (NMDs), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa*, amounting to PKR 218.32 million. As the design component was not undertaken by the firm, it was decided to consider 50% of the allocated marks for this project.

Subject: Minutes of Consultant Selection Committee (CSC) Meeting for Technical Evaluation of Proposals – Package-2, RGC Chachro, District Tharparkar

A meeting of the Consultant Selection Committee (CSC) was held on 17 December 2025 at 2:00 PM in the committee room of the Directorate, under the chairmanship of the Project Director, Project Management Implementation Unit (PMIU) – Rural Growth Centre (RGC), PRS. The meeting was convened to evaluate the technical proposals submitted on 11 December 2025 by interested consulting firms/consortia for the Design, Supervision, and Monitoring Consultancy Services for Package-2 of RGC Chachro, District Tharparkar.

2. The CSC conducted a detailed examination and evaluation of the technical proposals submitted by the following firms/consortia:

- i) RCC Consultants
- ii) CGD Consultant Pvt. Ltd.
- iii) EMC Pakistan Pvt. Ltd.
- iv) Epsilon Technologies
- v) B.M. Consulting Engineers Pvt. Ltd.
- vi) CG Consultants Pvt. Ltd. in JV with Ensibo Pvt. Ltd.

3. The evaluation was carried out strictly in accordance with the criteria specified in the RFP, comprising 20 marks for specific experience relevant to the assignment, 20 marks for adequacy of the proposed methodology in response to the Terms of Reference, and 60 marks for qualifications and competence of key professional staff, totalling 100 marks.

4. Initially, the eligibility criteria outlined in the RFP were assessed for all bidders. It was observed that M/s B.M. Consulting Engineers Pvt. Ltd. did not meet the requirement of having an average annual turnover of not less than PKR 100 million for the last three years, duly certified. Additionally, in the case of CG Consultants Pvt. Ltd. (Lead Firm) in JV with Ensibo Pvt. Ltd., the lead firm was found not to be registered with PEC, which is a mandatory requirement. Consequently, both firms were declared ineligible for further technical evaluation.

5. The Committee reviewed and evaluated the technical proposals of all participating firms against the approved evaluation criteria, including relevant experience, adequacy of the proposed methodology and work plan, and qualification and competence of key professional staff, with a total allocated score of 100 marks. The total scores of the firms/consortia are as follows:

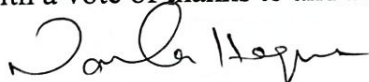

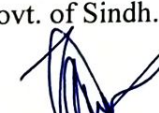

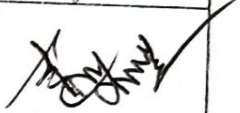
